Project Schedule

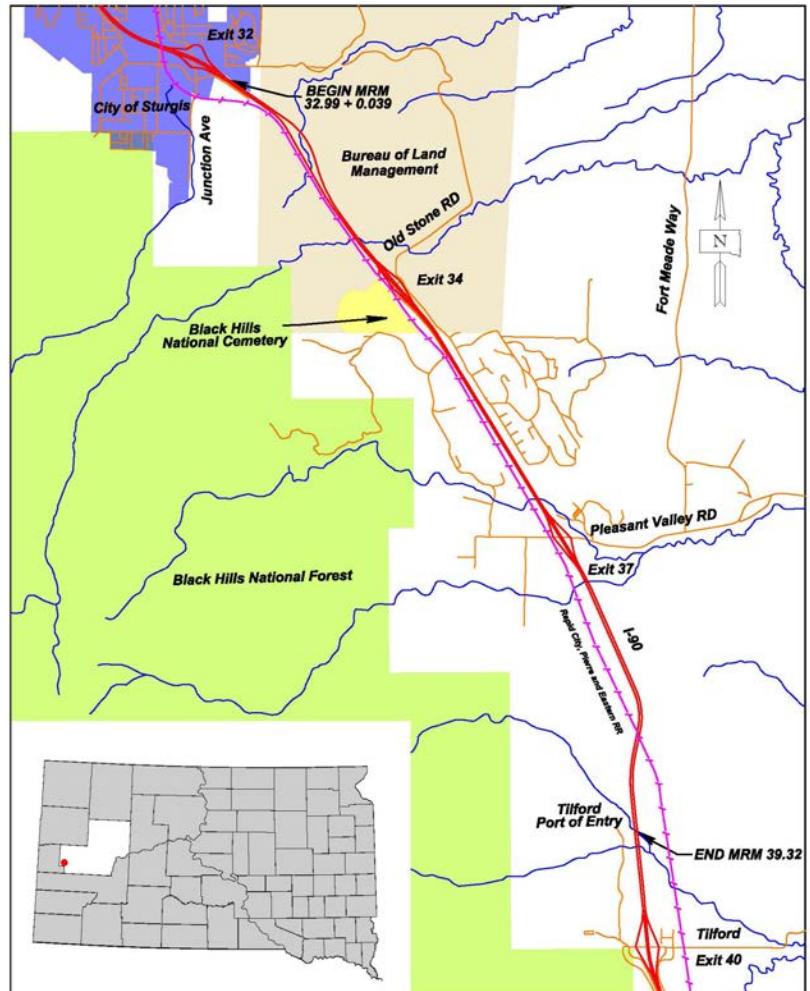
- 1 Corridor Study:
